GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION

To maintain our status as one of Colorado's top quality craft shows, your craft/art must first be juried. The jury committee begins the jury process in August for all categories except jewelry and continues throughout the year. Jewelry is juried in early January only and jewelry applications must be postmarked by December 31st.

Product must be handmade or substantially altered with your own creative additions (i.e.: a purchased plaque with your name on it, or a purchased chain with a purchased charm threaded on it, is NOT considered handmade). No purchased-for-resale product allowed except as noted below.

Jewelry: Include a detailed description of how you make your jewelry. Photos of you working in your workshop are recommended. We are looking for originally designed and handcrafted work. The jewelry category is highly competitive and we receive many more applications than space available.

Food Products: Homemade is preferred but commercial may be included at our discretion.

Note: Mollie McGee's has given "grandfather" status to a few vendors who do not meet all of the above criteria.

Note: A small amount of non-handcrafted product (not more than 20%) may be allowed in an individual booth if it enhances the handcrafted product (at least 80%). We reserve the right to include any products that enhance our shows.

ANSWERS TO FAQ'S

Unique, high quality, original crafts (with an attractive display booth) have the best chance of acceptance	Crafts are limited by category
Your space should be defined by backdrops and to-the-floor fire-retardant draping	NO Mart merchandise, wholesale catalog goods, or commercial vendors (see exception note above)
Two vendors can share a booth - use one application but include descriptions/information for both vendors	NO trapped animal products, imports or weapons and NO open flames or helium
Colorado tax license required - you collect and submit your own tax. 303-238-7378/www.taxcolorado.com for more information. Get a Special Event License	Food products require advance approval - send a copy of your current Health Dept. License with your application. Sanitary and safe food handling is mandatory

Acceptance Process

We will assign spaces until the category or show is full. Approximately 25% of the spaces are reserved for new exhibitors. We value our loyal repeat exhibitors and we are committed to offering shoppers new products. It is to your advantage to keep your product line up-to-date and unique with new designs and additions. First contract mailings and acceptance status notifications go out February 1 and continue throughout the year. Contracts will include payment deadline dates.

Sale of Business & Subletting

If a vendor sells their business, Mollie McGee's must be notified and the new owner must complete an application under his or her own name. Mollie McGee's will not "roll over" a business automatically. Also, no subletting of your space is allowed. If you must cancel, contact us and we will try to fill your space from our waiting list. If we can resell your space, a refund (less a cancellation fee) will be made.

Wait List

If the jury approves your craft but your craft category is sold out, you will be put on a waiting list. Cancellations can occur at any time.
